



GOAL: To procure on time and create a customer-relevant framework agreement and DPS



Adda CPB in numbers

- 1 200 customers municipalities, regions and their companies
- 150 framework agreements and dynamic purchasing systems – voluntary to use!
- Approx. 800 suppliers (86 % SME)
- Turnover € 1,3 billion on our FWA and DPS
- Financing 1.5% of the framework agreement's turnover is charged as administrative compensation from the supplier
- 80+ employees that produces 30-40 FWA and DPS per year








 - Agenda 2030 analysis


